

Invitation to tender for the provision of Construction Services to PFP 2 at FWITC Mafinga

1. INTRODUCTION

Participatory Plantation Forestry Programme (PFP 2) is a bilateral development programme implemented jointly by governments of Tanzania and Finland, with the expected impact being sustainable and inclusive plantation forestry that contributes to Tanzania's economic growth and poverty alleviation. The intended outcome of PFP 2 is that a socially sensitive, environmentally sustainable, and financially profitable plantation forestry sector including tree growers, SMEs, as well as their organisations and service providers, exists in the Southern Highlands of Tanzania. The programme strives to be human rights progressive, which involves safeguarding the rights of vulnerable groups and supporting their participation in the forestry value chain.

The Participatory Plantation Forestry Programme Phase 2 is seeking Proposals from qualified building contractors Tanzania based firms for provision of construction of classrooms services. The selection of contractor for this assignment will be carried out through restricted tendering.

Details of the assignment are outlined in the TORs (Annex 1).

2. INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMITTING TENDER

2.1 Contents of the tender

The tender should include the total price for the specified construction services to be provided, Experience of the contractor on similar work and payment terms. The language of the tender is English.

The tender should include completed tables relating to the requirements as shown in tender evaluation criteria and provide supporting documentation.

2.2 Deadline and maximum budget

Applications in response to this invitation to tender must be received by the PFP II Office not later than 5:00 p.m. on **Sunday 13th February 2022** for consideration. Bid applications that do not meet this deadline will not be evaluated.

The maximum budget for this assignment is TZS55 million (Fifty-five million only).

2.3 Tender selection criteria

The award criterion will be on highest scored points based on the criteria stated below.

ANNEX 1 TERMS OF REFERENCE

1. BACKGROUND

The Programme in its endeavour to support the participation in forestry value chain established a Forestry and Wood Industries Training Centre (FWITC) at Mafinga with aim of providing capacity building and training services for the stakeholders and beneficiaries of the Programme. FWITC offers training and technical advisory services for forestry and wood industries with wood processing and forestry facilities. FWITC's sawmill and the forest tree nursery have key functions in supporting the centre in its sustainable training activities. By producing forest products and tree seedlings the centre will generate income that will be used for maintaining and developing the centre, especially the infrastructure, machinery and equipment used in training. The centre will provide employment directly to local people close to the facilities and indirectly to farmers, forest owners and SME sawmillers within the Southern Highlands of Tanzania. Through the training provision the centre facilitates sustainable use and management of forest resources in Tanzania

Therefore, PFP-2 is now seeking a building contractor to provide a construction service as per drawings and bill of quantities tabulated below.
